MANDATORY REDUCTION MEASURES FOR WATER CONSERVATION

Stage II Reduction Measures

During a Stage II Water Shortage, the following mandatory water conservation practices regarding the use of potable water must be implemented.

- a. No washing down paved surfaces, including but not limited to sidewalks, driveways, parking lots, or patios, except when it is necessary to alleviate safety or sanitation hazards.
- b. No watering unpaved drive approaches, driveways, and sidewalks except when it is necessary to alleviate safety or sanitation hazards.
- c. No application of water to outdoor landscapes in a manner that causes undue or excessive runoff onto adjacent property, non-irrigated areas, private and public walkways, roadways, parking lots, or structures.
- e. Irrigate nursery and commercial grower's products before 9 a.m. and after 6 p.m. only. Watering is permitted at any time with a hand-held hose equipped with a positive shut-off nozzle, a bucket, or when a drip/micro-irrigation system/equipment is used. Irrigation of nursery propagation beds is permitted at any time. Watering of livestock is permitted at any time.
- f. The District shall provide prompt notice to a customer whenever the District obtains information that indicates that a leak may exist within the end-user's exclusive control. The customer must repair all water leaks within seventy two (72) hours of notification by the District unless other arrangements are made with the General Manager.
- g. Water landscaped areas, including trees and shrubs located on residential and commercial properties, and not irrigated by a landscape irrigation system, on the same schedule set forth in Item (f) below, by using a bucket, hand-held hose with a positive shut-off nozzle, or low-volume non-spray irrigation.
- h. No application of water to outdoor landscapes during and within 48 hours after measurable rainfall.
- i. Commercial, industrial, and institutional properties, such as campuses, golf courses, and cemeteries, shall implement water efficiency measures to reduce water usage as may be required by the State of California, the State Water Resources Control Board, or other appropriate state agency.
- j. The irrigating of "non-functional turf" at commercial, industrial, and institutional properties, such as grass in front of or next to large industrial or commercial buildings is prohibited. This prohibition does not include turf that is used for recreational purposes, or for civic or community events, and does not apply for residences, or for watering to maintain trees.

SUGGESTED REDUCTION MEASURES FOR WATER CONSERVATION

- a. Use only re-circulated water to operate ornamental fountains or decorative water features.
- b. Only wash vehicles using a bucket and a hand-held hose with positive shut-off nozzle, mobile high pressure/low volume wash system, or at a commercial site that re-circulates (reclaims) water on-site. Avoid washing during hot conditions (over 95 degrees F) when additional water is required due to evaporation.
- c. Serve and refill water in restaurants, hotels, cafes, cafeterias, bars, or other public places where food or drink are served and/or purchased only upon request.
- d. Operators of hotels and motels should provide guests with the option of choosing not to have towels and linens laundered daily. The hotel or motel should provide guests with the option in each guestroom using clear and easily understood language.
- e. Use recycle or non-potable water for construction purposes when available.
- f. Watering of outdoor residential and commercial landscapes will be limited to certain days of the week as follows:
Residences and commercial properties with even-numbered addresses will be able to water on Sunday, Wednesday, and Friday.
Residences and commercial properties with odd-numbered addresses will be able to water on Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday.
Watering of outdoor landscapes will not be allowed on Monday.
- e. Watering of outdoor landscapes will be limited to the hours between 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. only.
